What is ISO and Why Does It Matter?

ISO: The International Organization for Standardization

A non-governmental organization that develops and publishes standards for a wide range of industries.

Importance of ISO

ISO certification demonstrates a commitment to quality, efficiency, and safety, enhancing credibility and customer trust.

ISO (International Organization for Standardization) certifications can be categorized into two main types based on accreditation:

1. IAF Accredited ISO Certification

- IAF (International Accreditation Forum) accreditation ensures that the certification body issuing the ISO certificate is recognized globally and follows international accreditation standards.
- These certifications are issued by certification bodies accredited by IAF member accreditation bodies (e.g., UKAS, ANAB, NABCB).
- Examples: ISO 9001 (Quality Management), ISO 14001 (Environmental Management), ISO 27001 (Information Security), etc.
- Recognition: Globally accepted and preferred for businesses dealing with international clients.



2. IAF Accredited ISO Certification

- These certifications re issued by non-IAF accredited bodies.
- They may still follow ISO standards but lack global accreditation and recognition.
- Often used for internal compliance, marketing, or business reputation.
- Recognition: Limited acceptance, primarily within specific markets or industries.
